

JJSPLIT V1.23 README

DESCRIPTION

JJSplit v1.23 is used to Split large files into smaller parts that end with .v1, .v2 and so on... for easier transferring over the internet or any other purposes and also to join those parts(.v1,.v2 files.. and also .001, .002 files..) back into the original filename.

There are already many alternatives but this is faster than them. I've also added more features that user's want. Also you can alter the code to customize the way you want.

LICENSE

JJSplit is registered in Sourceforge under Public Domain License which means anybody can do anything with the source code as if they are the owner. I made this for educational purposes and if you wish to make it better, you are welcome.

FEATURES

- Option to delete the parts one by one while joining
- Right Click menu to join the files(Windows Only)
- Portable
- Platform independent
- Multithreaded
- Supports joining the popular .001, .002 split-files as well

INSTALLATION AND USE

FOR MACOS, LINUX, SOLARIS AND OTHER OS USERS

Simply execute the JJSplit.jar file

FOR WINDOWS USERS

You can install the JJSplit to access the additional features. You can still execute JJSplit.jar in a portable manner.

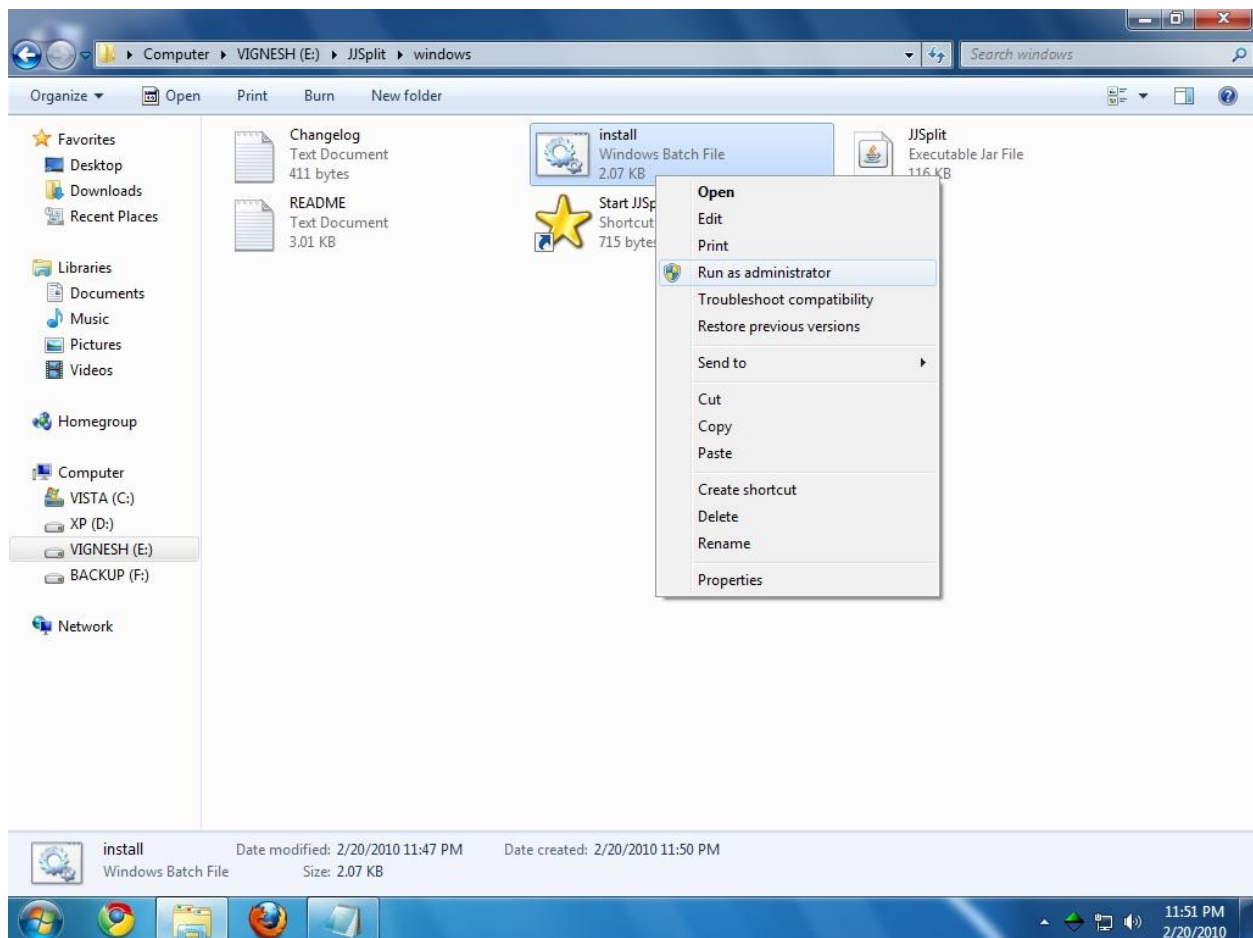
Note: Some programs like WinRAR, Nokia PCSuite may associate themselves with the jar files preventing them to be self-executable. So in that case, use the shortcut icon or run.bat(which will be created by install.bat)

WINDOWS INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

If you use Windows 7 or Windows Vista,

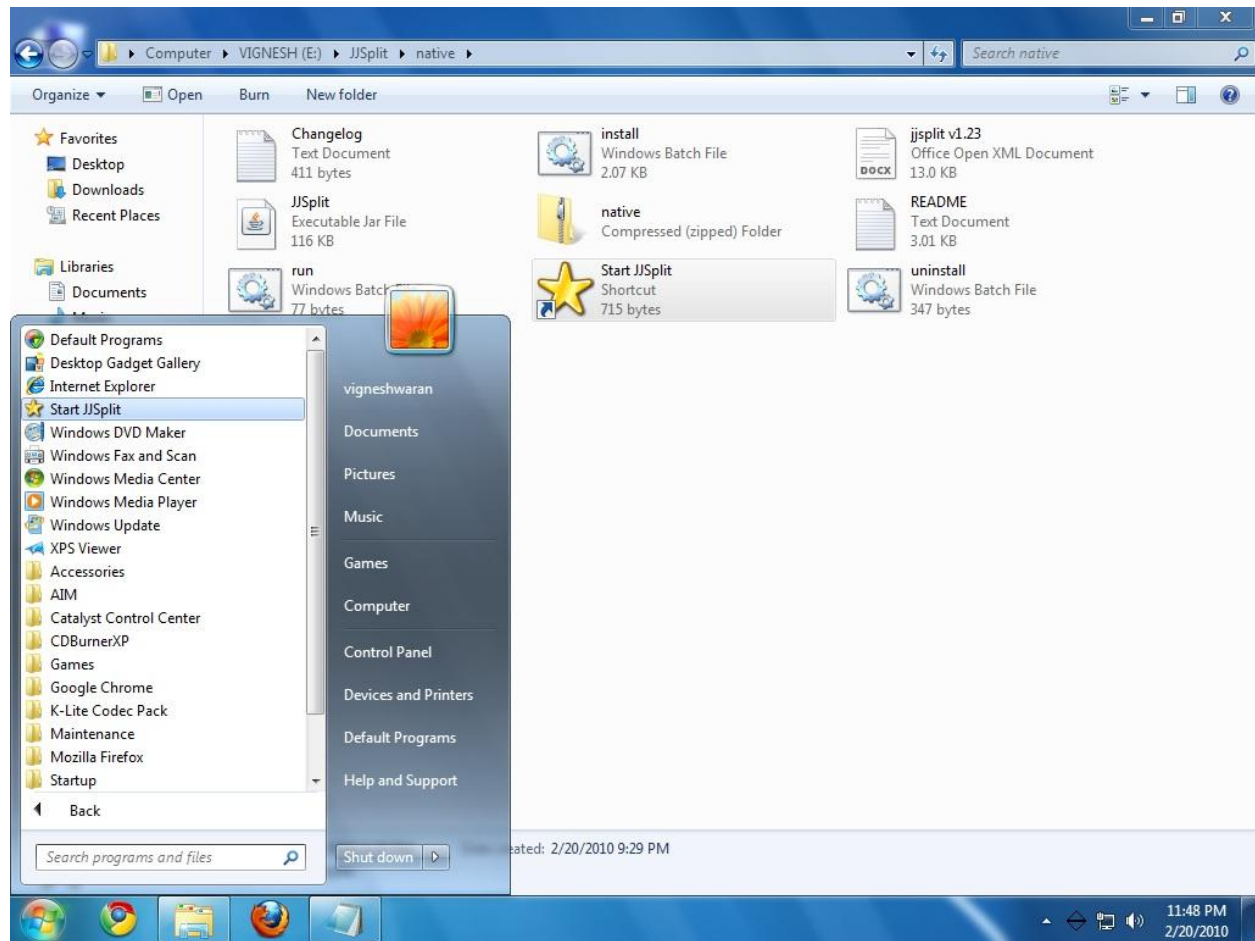
Select the install.bat file and Select Run as Administrator.

If you use previous versions of Windows, simply double click install.bat



Note: The install.bat will copy the JJSplit to system32 folder and creates registry entries for associating JJSplit with .v1 and .001 files so that they can be joined easily using Context Menu. Then it creates run.bat and uninstall.bat. You may edit this batch file to suit your needs.

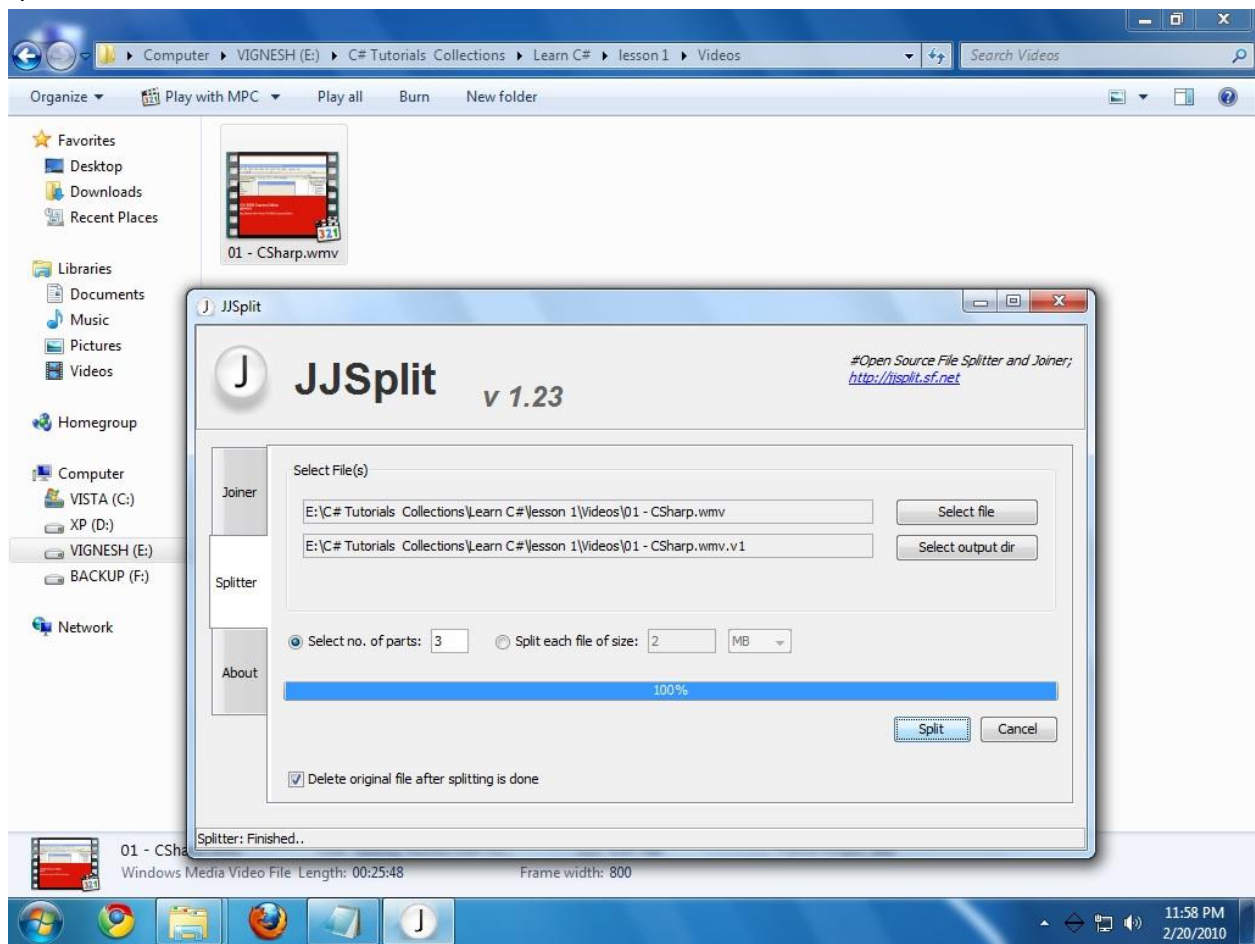
You may also drag the shortcut icon to Start menu for quicker access.



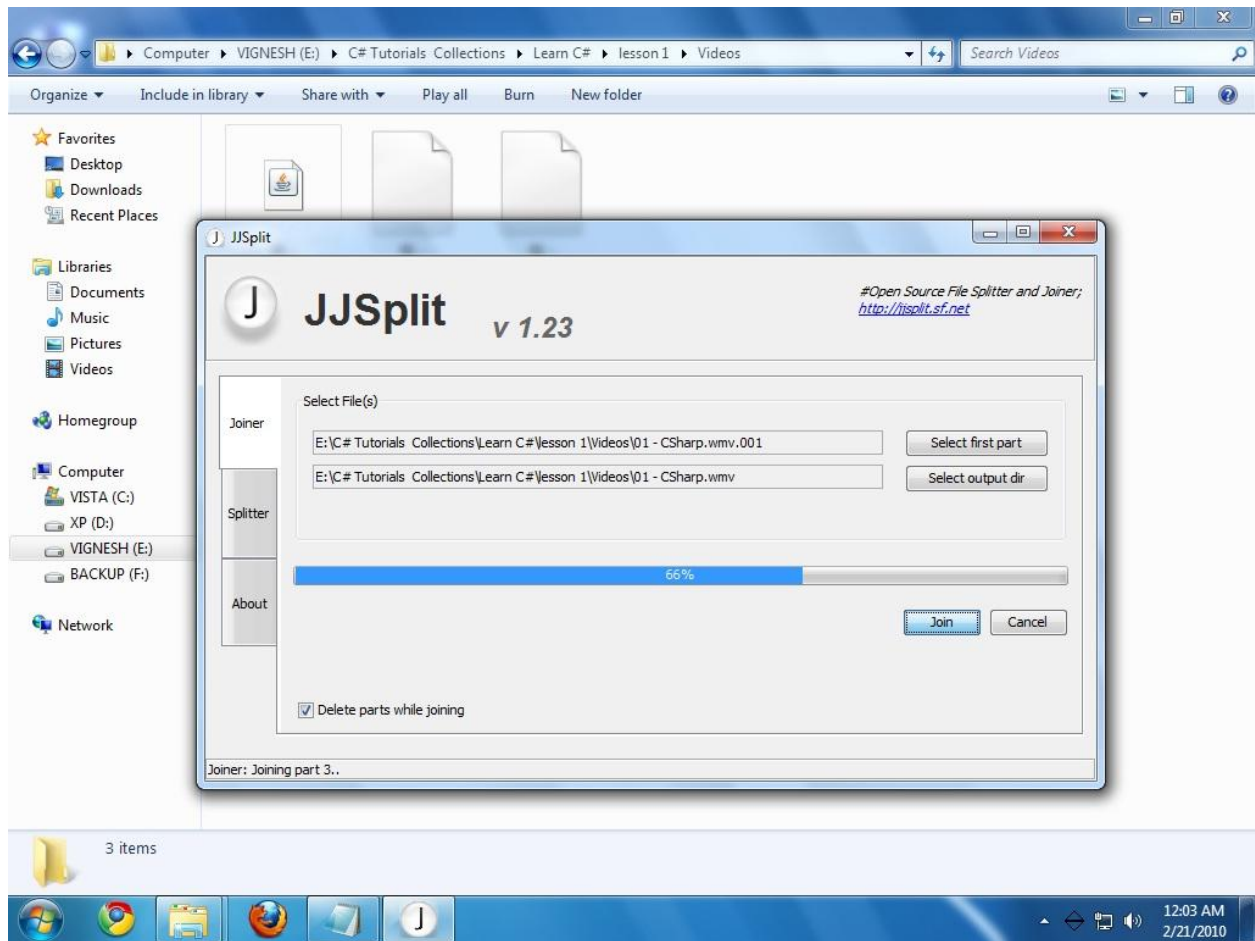
Once you've opened JJSplit, have some fun. Select the Splitter tab and split some large file like a large video file into 7 parts, for eg. Then try joining those parts back to original file using the Joiner tab.

Splitter:

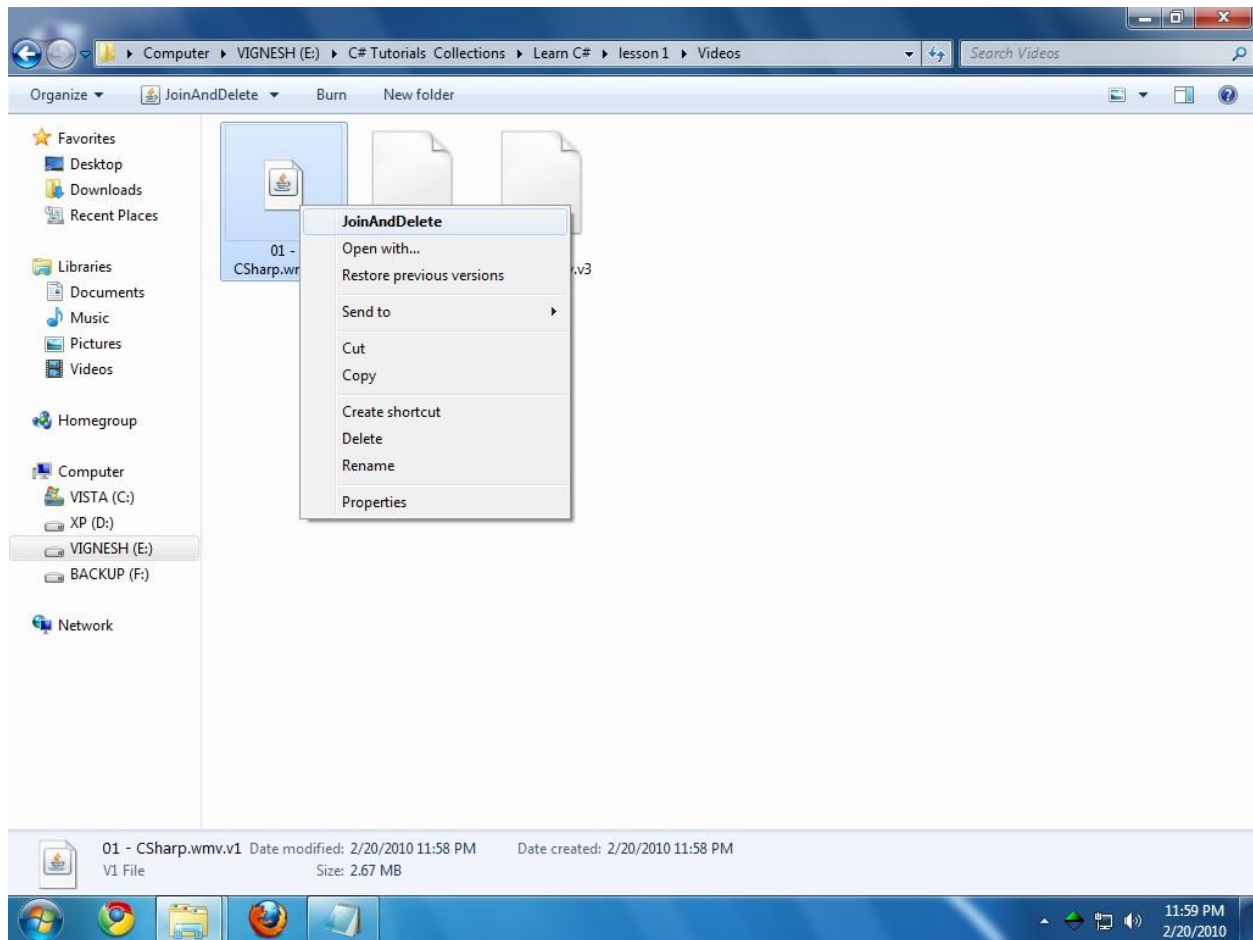


Joiner:



JoinAndDelete Menu(Windows Only):

Right click the first part (.v1 or .001) to join the parts.



KNOWN ISSUES

- JJSplit is built on Swing, so the initial run will be slower for some old PCs. Don't think it's not opening.
- If you split a very very large file, then the progress bar will take some time to make its initial move. Don't be scared.
- Click the Join/Split button only once. If you click again and again, then it'll make new new threads for the same file and the progress bar will go crazy.
- If you downloaded themed version of JJSplit instead of system default version, they might not handle user's mistakes like the system default one does. But they are the same when it comes to splitting and joining.
