Quick Start Guide...

Steps Overview

1. Run `SafeAsHouses.exe`
2. The default password is password
3. Click `Change Logon Password` to change the password
4. Start adding logon information to be stored securely

Notes

- The application will only allow access to one user at a time in order to prevent conflicts. If the application crashes, it may report a user is logged in when they aren't. To fix this, run `SafeAsHouses_Repairer.exe` in the components folder.
- The passwords are encrypted using a combination of fingerprints and AES. The logon password is also a hash/salt value increasing the security further.
- Don't delete the `zzzzz` entry at the bottom of the list. This is a unique fingerprint to increase security.
- To increase security, if this is used on an Active Directory Domain, then secure the folder via NTFS permissions.
- Always back up the components folder as this holds the data. Don't tamper with the files as they have protection and if the application notices, it will stop working. If this happens, restore the components folder from your backup.
